Ambedkar Jayanti Quiz Competition 2026

1. Introduction & Background –

To honor the 135th birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the chief architect of the Indian Constitution and a relentless crusader for social justice, Mahatma Gandhi College, Darbhanga organized the Ambedkar Jayanti Quiz Competition 2026 from 10 April to 14 April. The initiative was conceived to move beyond ceremonial tributes and foster active academic engagement with Dr. Ambedkar's multifaceted legacy as a jurist, economist, social reformer, and nation-builder. Located in Bihar's Mithila region, where questions of equity and access remain deeply relevant, the college recognized a gap between students' symbolic respect for Dr. Ambedkar and their substantive understanding of his work on constitutional morality, labor rights, economic policy, and annihilation of caste. Therefore, an inter-college online quiz was designed as a democratic, inclusive platform open to all students without any registration fee or institutional barrier, reflecting Dr. Ambedkar's own belief that education must be accessible to all. Conducted on a zero-budget model through voluntary faculty efforts, the quiz covered his writings, reforms, and philosophy to present him not just as the "Father of the Constitution" but as a comprehensive thinker whose ideas continue to guide contemporary India. The five-day schedule leading up to 14 April encouraged self-study and peer discussion, ensuring participation was driven by genuine interest rather than compulsion. This background sets the context for the report that follows, documenting an event where remembrance was translated into learning and constitutional values were practiced through action.

2. Participation & Result Summary

The event was executed using existing digital infrastructure and voluntary support from faculty members. No financial burden was placed on any stakeholder.

5. Outcome & Achievements

1. 94.85% Success Rate: 129 out of 136 participants secured 50% or above.
2. Inter-College Engagement: Participation from multiple institutions promoted constitutional literacy.
3. Zero-Cost Model: Proved that impactful academic events can be organized without financial resources.
4. Academic Rigor: With 30 questions and 50% cutoff, the quiz maintained standards while ensuring inclusivity.

6. Certificate Distribution

Certificates of Appreciation were digitally issued only to the 129 students who scored 15 marks or above. The certificate acknowledged their active participation and qualifying knowledge about Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's life and legacy. The 7 students who did not meet the qualifying criteria were encouraged to participate in future academic events.

A defining feature of this initiative was its zero-budget, zero-fee model. Without any financial support from the college, external organizations, or students, the quiz was executed entirely through voluntary faculty efforts and existing digital infrastructure. This proved that impactful academic engagement does not require monetary resources but relies on institutional will, planning, and collective responsibility. It also embodied Dr. Ambedkar's principle that education and opportunity must not be restricted by economic barriers.

Beyond numbers, the quiz fostered inter-college dialogue and constitutional literacy at a time when democratic values need active reinforcement among youth. It reminded participants that Dr. Ambedkar's call to "Educate, Agitate, Organize" is not a slogan but a method of social transformation. For Mahatma Gandhi College, this event reaffirms the institution's commitment to value-based education and its role in nurturing informed, responsible citizens. The organizing committee believes that such initiatives should become a regular practice, ensuring that Ambedkar Jayanti is not observed as a ritual but as an annual renewal of our engagement with justice, equality, and fraternity. The success of this quiz encourages us to expand such efforts in the future.
