Veer Kunwar Singh Jayanti Quiz Competition 2026

1. Introduction & Background –

Veer Kunwar Singh Jayanti is celebrated on 23rd April each year to remember the birth anniversary of Babu Veer Kunwar Singh, the fearless hero of Jagdishpur who became a central figure in the 1857 Revolt. Despite being nearly 80 years old and wounded, he led his army against British forces with remarkable strategy and courage across Bihar and Uttar Pradesh. He liberated Jagdishpur from colonial control and sacrificed his life for the motherland on 26th April 1858, just days after his victory. His life reflects unshakable patriotism, leadership, and the spirit of resistance that continues to inspire Indians today. Recognising the need to spread awareness about such regional freedom fighters among the youth, Mahatma Gandhi College, Darbhanga organised an online quiz to mark his 248th birth anniversary in 2026. The Veer Kunwar Singh Jayanti Quiz 2026 was conducted from 17 April 2026 to 23 April 2026 and was open to students of multiple colleges and universities across Bihar and other states. The initiative aimed to provide a common academic platform where students from diverse institutions could learn about Veer Kunwar Singh's role in the First War of Independence and the broader history of India's freedom struggle. Through this quiz, participants engaged with questions on his life, battles, governance, and legacy. The event was designed not merely as a test of knowledge but as a medium to develop historical consciousness, national pride, and respect for sacrifice. By involving students from various academic institutions, the quiz encouraged collective remembrance and highlighted the importance of regional heroes in shaping India's independence movement for future generations.

The event was executed using existing digital infrastructure and voluntary support from faculty members. No financial burden was placed on any stakeholder.

5. Outcome & Achievements

1. 92.78% Success Rate: 90 out of 97 participants secured 50% or above.
2. Inter-College Engagement: Participation from multiple institutions promoted constitutional literacy.
3. Zero-Cost Model: Proved that impactful academic events can be organized without financial resources.
4. Academic Rigor: With 30 questions and 50% cutoff, the quiz maintained standards while ensuring inclusivity.

6. Certificate Distribution

Certificates of Appreciation were digitally issued only to the 90 students who scored 15 marks or above. The certificate acknowledged their active participation and qualifying knowledge about Veer Kunwar Singh's life and legacy. The 7 students who did not meet the qualifying criteria were encouraged to participate in future academic events.

This proved that impactful academic engagement does not require monetary resources but relies on institutional will, planning, and collective responsibility. It also embodied the spirit that knowledge about our freedom fighters and their sacrifice must not be restricted by economic barriers.

Beyond numbers, the quiz fostered inter-college dialogue and historical awareness at a time when national consciousness needs active reinforcement among youth. It reminded participants that Veer Kunwar Singh's courage and sacrifice are not just stories of the past but guiding principles for patriotism and resilience.
