GST Day Quiz Competition 2026

1. Introduction & Background –

To observe GST Day, Mahatma Gandhi College, Darbhanga organised the GST Day Quiz Competition 2026 from 27 June 2026 to 01 July 2026. The initiative was conceptualised to move beyond ceremonial observances and to foster substantive academic engagement with critical economic and taxation issues. Situated in Bihar's Mithila region, where awareness of taxation, financial literacy, and the formal economy has direct bearing on business, employment, and governance, the college identified a gap between students' basic awareness of GST and their informed understanding of concepts such as GST structure, input tax credit, compliance, e-way bill, digital payments, and GST's role in national development. Accordingly, an inter-college online quiz was structured as a democratic and inclusive platform, open to all students without registration fee or institutional restriction, reflecting the principle that financial and tax awareness must be accessible to every learner. Conducted on a zero-budget model through voluntary faculty contribution, the quiz addressed themes of GST framework, indirect taxation, economic reform, digital economy, and India's fiscal policy. Its objective was to position GST not merely as a tax reform, but as a shared responsibility requiring informed participation in nation-building.

The competition recorded participation from 142 students across various colleges, of whom 126 participants successfully qualified. This outcome indicates strong learning engagement and awareness. This background provides the context for the report that follows, documenting an event in which economic consciousness was translated into active learning and financial literacy was reinforced through academic practice.

2. Participation & Result Summary

The event was executed using existing digital infrastructure and voluntary support from faculty members. No financial burden was placed on any stakeholder.

5. Outcome & Achievements

1. 88.73% Success Rate: 126 out of 142 participants secured 50% or above.
2. Inter-College Engagement: Participation from multiple institutions promoted constitutional literacy.
3. Zero-Cost Model: Proved that impactful academic events can be organized without financial resources.
4. Academic Rigor: With 30 questions and 50% cutoff, the quiz maintained standards while ensuring inclusivity.

6. Certificate Distribution

Certificates of Appreciation were digitally issued to the 126 students who scored 15 marks or above. The certificate recognised their active participation and qualifying understanding of key GST concepts including GST structure, input tax credit, compliance, digital payments, and the role of GST in economic development. The remaining 16 students who did not meet the qualifying criteria were encouraged to participate in future academic and financial literacy events to strengthen their knowledge base.

By covering themes of GST framework, indirect taxation, economic reform, digital economy, and India's fiscal policy, the quiz encouraged participants to view GST as a shared responsibility in nation building rather than a distant subject.

A defining feature of this initiative was its zero-budget, zero-fee model. Without any financial support from the college, external organisations, or students, the quiz was executed entirely through voluntary faculty efforts and existing digital infrastructure. This proved that impactful academic engagement does not require monetary resources but relies on institutional intent, planning, and collective responsibility. It also embodied the GST Day principle that financial literacy and tax awareness must be accessible to all, irrespective of economic background.

Beyond numbers, the quiz fostered inter-college dialogue and economic literacy at a time when awareness of taxation and the formal economy needs active reinforcement among youth. It reminded participants that GST is not just a tax reform but a practice for transparency, ease of business, and long-term economic growth. For Mahatma Gandhi College, this event reaffirms the institution's commitment to value-based education and its role in nurturing informed, responsible citizens. The organising committee believes that such initiatives should become a regular practice, ensuring that GST Day is observed not merely as a ceremony but as an annual renewal of our commitment to financial literacy and economic responsibility. The success of this quiz encourages us to expand such efforts in the future.
