World Population Day Quiz Competition 2026

1. Introduction & Background –

To observe World Population Day from 07 July 2026 to 11 July 2026, Mahatma Gandhi College, Darbhanga organized the World Population Day Quiz Competition 2026. The initiative was conceptualized to move beyond ceremonial observances and to foster substantive academic engagement with critical demographic and social issues. Situated in Bihar's Mithila region, where challenges of high population density, resource pressure, youth health, education, gender equity, and migration have direct bearing on development and quality of life, the college identified a gap between students' general awareness of population issues and their informed understanding of concepts such as population growth, sustainable development, family planning, reproductive health, literacy, urbanization, and government population policies. Accordingly, an inter-college online quiz was structured as a democratic and inclusive platform, open to all students without registration fee or institutional restriction, reflecting the principle that social awareness must be accessible to every learner. Conducted on a zero-budget model through voluntary faculty contribution, the quiz addressed themes of demography, youth empowerment, gender equality, health and education, migration, and government initiatives for population and development. Its objective was to position population issues not merely as an academic subject, but as a shared responsibility requiring informed action and responsible citizenship. The competition recorded participation from 170 students across various colleges, of whom 162 participants successfully qualified with a passing percentage of 95.29 percent. This outcome indicates strong learning engagement and awareness. This background provides the context for the report that follows, documenting an event in which social consciousness was translated into active learning and demographic values were reinforced through academic practice.

The event was executed using existing digital infrastructure and voluntary support from faculty members. No financial burden was placed on any stakeholder.

5. Outcome & Achievements

1. 95.29% Success Rate: 162 out of 170 participants secured 50% or above.
2. Inter-College Engagement: Participation from multiple institutions promoted constitutional literacy.
3. Zero-Cost Model: Proved that impactful academic events can be organized without financial resources.
4. Academic Rigor: With 30 questions and 50% cutoff, the quiz maintained standards while ensuring inclusivity.

6. Certificate Distribution

Certificates of Appreciation were digitally issued to the 162 students who scored 15 marks or above. The certificate recognized their active participation and qualifying understanding of key population and social concepts including population growth, sustainable development, family planning, reproductive health, gender equality, literacy, and government population policies. The remaining 8 students who did not meet the qualifying criteria were encouraged to participate in future academic and social awareness events to strengthen their knowledge base.

A defining feature of this initiative was its zero-budget, zero-fee model.
